Sermon Notes

A Mountain Top Experience (A God Moment)

Mark 9:1-8

Thesis: "You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:11-13)

- I. "After six days Jesus <u>took</u> Peter, James, and John with him and <u>led</u> them up a high mountain, where they were all <u>alone</u>..." (vs2a)
 - A. Jesus reveals that our God desires to meet with us on a <u>personal</u> level.
 - "Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded." (James 4:8)
 - 'For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart." (Jeremiah 29:11-13)
- II. "There he was <u>transfigured</u> before them. His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them." (Vs2b-3)
 - A. Jesus allowed Peter, James, and John to experience the Glory of God.
 - 1. Every Christian should <u>cherish</u> the special encounters they may have with God.
 a. They are often referred to as "<u>God</u> Moments" or "Mountain Top Experiences" of "Spiritual Breakthroughs"!
 - b. They often come during times of <u>worship</u>, while <u>praying</u> or while reading his Word.
 - B. The three disciples witnessed the <u>restoring</u> of Jesus' glory that he had with the Father. C. John <u>describes</u> Jesus' post-resurrected/glorified state. (**Read Revelations 1:9-19**)
- III. "And there appeared before them <u>Elijah</u> and <u>Moses</u>, who were talking with Jesus." (vs4)
 - A. Moses and Elijah were used by God mightily in the Old Testament regarding Salvation history.
 - Moses had been transfigured at Mount Sinai while receiving the Ten <u>Commandments</u>. (Read Exodus 34:29-35)
 - 2. Elijah had been transfigured in the "<u>Chariot</u> of Fire" experience when he went to be with God. (**Read II Kings 2 11-12**)
- IV. 'Peter said to Jesus, "Rabbi, it is <u>good</u> for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters--one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah."(vs5)
 - A. The Disciples experienced "A God Moment"!
 - 1. There is nothing like an overwhelming "God Moment"
 - Peter declared, "It is good for us to be here."
 - 2. You often do not want to leave.
 - Peter declared, "Let us put up three shelters..."
 - B. That is why the Word of God invites you to seek God!
 - "Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded." (James 4:8)
 - C. The disciples were "frightened". (Read Daniel 10: 1-12)
- V. Then a cloud appeared and overshadowed them. A voice came out of the cloud and said, "This is my Son, whom I love. Keep on listening to him!"(vs7)
 - A. The Disciples witnessed "God the Father" giving a personal <u>confirmation</u> to "God the Son".
 - 1. God is faithful and will give us spiritual confirmation as we $\underline{\text{sincerely}}$ seek Him.
 - "Blessed are those who <u>hunger</u> and <u>thirst</u> for righteousness, for they will be filled." (Matthew 5:6)
