## Sermon 4: Blessing the Broken and Needy in Our Communities

Scripture: Luke 14:12-14

Main Idea: Jesus calls us to help the marginalized and needy in our communities.

## To help the marginalized and needy in our communities we must:

- 1. Have hearts and hands ready for *action*. v. 13a
  - We must be the hands and feet of Jesus to those who are hurting and broken.
    - Galatians 6:2-5 & 1 Timothy 6:18
- 2. Identify the Invisible v. 13b
  - We need to identify the marginalized and needy in our communities.
    - Proverbs 28:27 & Psalm 41:1
- 3. Expect a harvest of healing and transformation. v. 14
  - Blessing the broken and needy can lead to transformation and healing.
    - Blessing others:
      - $\checkmark$  Restores dignity and hope.
      - ✓ Break cycles of despair.
      - ✓ Builds community and connection.
      - ✓ Brings about emotional healing and resilience.
      - ✓ Inspires a pay-it-forward mentality.
      - $\checkmark~$  Brings about greater physical well-being.
      - $\checkmark$  Fosters spiritual transformation.
      - ✓ Breaks isolation.
      - ✓ Empowers others to develop skills.
      - ✓ Witnesses God's love in action.

## **Action Points:**

- □ Look out for those that are "invisible" in our communities.
- □ Be ready to meet their needs or join with others to do so as God gives opportunities.
- Expect God to work through your faith and actions and celebrate when He does.
