"The Unexpected King" Matthew 21:1-11

Main Idea: Jesus' humble entry into Jerusalem as a peaceful king challenges us to reconsider our expectations of Him and to embrace His mission of love and service in our lives.

Introduction – Umbrella Faith

Who is this Unexpected King?

- 1. The King who fulfills Prophecy v. 4
 - What the people expected then: (Zechariah 9:9-17)
 - o A triumphant king (Zech. 9:10)
 - o A rescuing king (Zech 9:11-12)
 - o A warrior king (Zech 9:13)
 - o A <u>righteous</u> king (Zech 9:14–17)
- 2. The King who Inspires Worship v.9
 - What the people can receive now:
 - o Jesus Christ is the triumphant King! (1 Corinthians 15:54-57)
 - o Jesus Christ is the rescuing King! (2 Timothy 2:22-26)
 - o Jesus Christ is the warrior King! (Rev. 19:11-16)
 - o Jesus Christ is the righteous King! (1 John 2:1-6)

3. The King who Shakes things up - v.10-11

- The Critical Question: "Who is this?"
 - o Matthew 2:3; Matthew 16:13-20; Matthew 27:20-26

Action Steps: Lay Down your Cloak

- Settle the Question "Who is Jesus and what role does He play in your life?"
- Align your life with Jesus' Mission.
- Live out the Message.


